ENSURING PROSPERITY & SECURITY FOR EVERY UTAHN






LIFE: PROTECTING HEALTH AND SAFETY

- Stand against targeting or discrimination based on identity, background, or beliefs, ensuring all individuals feel safe, valued, and protected under the law.




PURSUIT OF HAPPINESS: BUILDING THRIVING COMMUNITIES
